- At the last LESP meeting on 24 March, the Improvement Service emphasised the importance of the LESP improving its joint working. This resulted in the self-assessment questionnaire which members of the LESP were invited to complete.
- The questionnaire focussed on how well-prepared the partners felt about the LESP delivering on NOLB.
- We were asked to consider nine areas with over 50 measurements for improvement. There were seven responders to the survey.
- The LEP used break-out groups to identify priorities from the list of those that had low scores in the survey.
- Four areas emerged as broad thematic priorities:
 - o Governance
 - User Voices
 - Scrutiny and smart targets
 - Self-evaluation
- The actions will be linked to one of the four themes and shared with the LESP ahead of the next meeting on 23 June.
