1. I asked for a rolling action log to be added to the minutes. This was agreed. I was keen to ensure that the update on windfarms and ideas for its use was not lost.
2. I gave a presentation on the Digital Exclusion Research and the extended analysis focussing on poverty and its impact on digital exclusion/restriction.
3. There is to be a revised template for monitoring and evaluation; colleagues were asked to comment by 29 March
4. There are another 4000 tackling poverty leaflets on order.
5. Regarding windfarms; the subgroup 3 has contacted all windfarm management committees to invite them to consider anti-poverty projects with support from DGC. WJ offered to send me the letter that was sent out to the windfarms and share the response.
6. Sub group 4 is working on developing a plan which focuses on six priorities which will address the barriers to parents returning to work.
