THIRD SECTOR DUMFRIES AND GALLOWAY SUMMARY

Working together to put our sector first Dumfries and Galloway's Third Sector Interface

KEY POINTS

- 1. The changes to the membership of the REP were agreed this will mean that the TSIs are automatically included in the membership, and each will be asked to nominate a representative.
- 2. The REP will be enlarged to include Historic Environment Scotland, Regional NHS boards, SSDA.
- 3. The measurement framework is still being developed. A draft will be shared at the December meeting.
- 4. SoSE asked for volunteers to sense check the framework.
- The SoSE rep summarised the results of their survey on the impact of the cost of living crisis on businesses in SoS. Report link <u>here</u>. There will be lobbying as a result of the survey. I mentioned our own survey and agreed to share the results with Karen Jackson.
- 6. DGC and SBC presented on progress with the Shared Prosperity Fund. The slide presentation is <u>here</u>.
- 7. SBC's Sam Smith indicated that it is possible to have in-year flexibility, I asked if DGC would be willing to ask for carry forward underspend from Y1 to Y2.
- 8. The REP is charged with giving direction, monitoring progress and providing promotion. LAs are responsible for administration of SPF.
- 9. I made several points:
 - a. The move to administer the funds via local authorities was welcomed initially as being closer to communities than in EU funding. This confidence is now hanging by a thread.
 - b. Almost 40% of TSIs were involved in writing of the investment plan or asked to comment on the draft of the plan.
 - c. I asked three questions: how will strategic decisions be made about the SPF such as ring fencing for TS? How do we progress a decision about the carry forward of underspend from Y1 to Y2? What process will be put in place for TS to access the SPF?
 - d. How will LEADER replacement fund work alongside SPF?
- 10. It was agreed that I would receive separate answers to these from DGC I emailed Steve Rogers at DGC immediately after the meeting with these questions.
- 11. The REP held a workshop on Land Use policy. Feedback will be made at the next REP.
